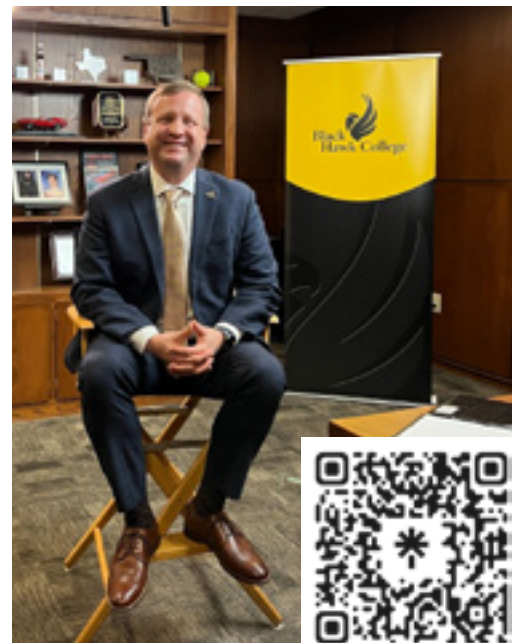

She later transferred to Western Illinois University, earning her Bachelor of Science degree in 1988. While at WIU, Tami was a dedicated member of the Hoof & Horn Club, helped launch the annual steer and heifer show, managed the swine test station, and contributed to the bull and ram test stations.

Following graduation, Tami managed a western retail store in Peru, Illinois, eventually serving as purchasing manager across multiple locations. In 1996, she joined Green Gables Furniture, where she served first as a store manager and later as district manager, overseeing eight stores.



In 2001, Tami returned to her agricultural roots, working as an office manager for Burroughs Ag. After several transitions in ownership, she found a new path in workforce development. 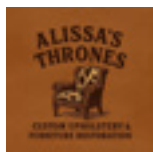

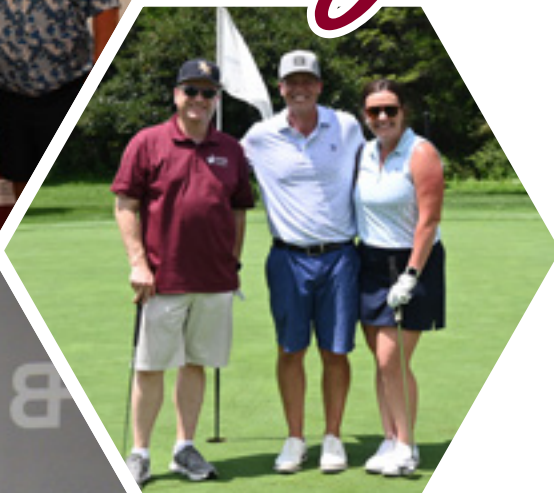
